



Lucille C. Murphy

May 15, 1928 - June 24, 2022

Hampton - Native French speaker, pianist, seamstress, devout Catholic, avid Red Sox fan, Lucille Claire (Blais) Murphy died peacefully at her home in Seabrook Beach on June 24, 2022.

She was raised in Lawrence, the youngest of six children of William and Anna (Morin) Blais, and graduated from St Anne's High School.

Lu began work as a burler at the old Pacific Mills. She later used her French and office skills while employed at Mary Immaculate Nursing Home and Lady Finelle Cosmetics in Lawrence, and Holy Family Hospital in Methuen.

While working at the American News Company on South Union Street, she met WW2 vet Laurence Murphy. Larry and Lu married in 1950 and enjoyed 57 years together, drawn by their interest in the Catholic Church, classical music, and family activities. On one of their first dates, they attended an out-of-town Boston tryout of a new musical: Rogers and Hammerstein's South Pacific. They spent their honeymoon in Bartlett NH. Later vacations took them to Ireland, Switzerland, and Hawaii. Larry and Lu celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary at the Chateau Frontenac in Quebec, their favorite city.

Lucille was a daily communicant for much of her life. She served as lector for 38 years at Holy Trinity (Lawrence) and Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal

(Hampton) parishes. Although she loved to cook, Lu was a frequent patron of Ute Pineo and Al Gauron's Luncheonette at Hampton Harbor.

Lu was a gracious and beautiful soul both inside and out. She held a favored spot in our hearts as a family, and the mere mention of her name brought a smile to our lips. She was incapable of holding grudges, and loved everyone equally.

Lucille was predeceased by her husband Laurence, and siblings Jeannette, Roland, Herve, Lionel, Alcide. She is survived by her son Mike and many nieces and nephews.

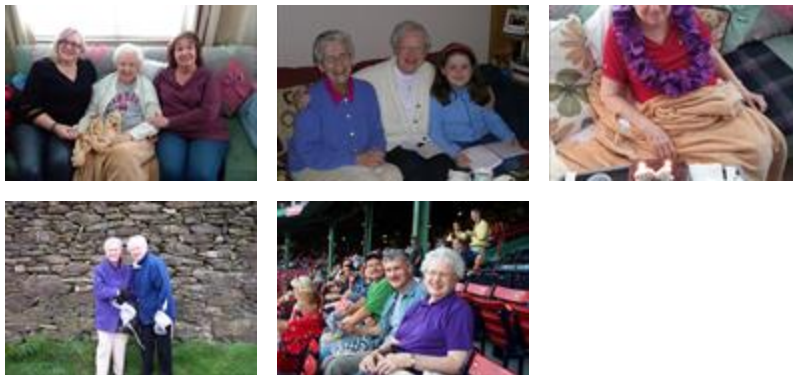
