



## Margaret "Peg" Arguin

August 12, 1932 - May 10, 2015

Dover – Margaret M. “Peg” Arguin, 82, formerly of Hampton, died peacefully Sunday, May 10, 2015 at Riverside Rest Home in Dover with her two daughters by her side.

She was born in Berlin, August 12, 1932 the daughter of the late Silvio and Yvonne (Valliere) Ottolini, was raised there and graduated from Belin High School.

She shared 62 years of marriage with her late husband, Bernard L. “Ben” Arguin who predeceased her in 2014.

Peg and Ben moved their family to Hampton in 1966 coming from Berlin. 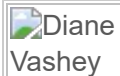

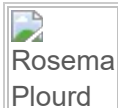
