



## Margaret L. (Condrey) McElholm

May 6, 1912 - April 18, 2013

Exeter – Margaret L. “Peg” (Condrey) McElholm, 100, of Exeter, formerly of Lowell, MA, died Thursday, April 18, 2013 at Langdon Place of Exeter where she has resided since 2011.

She was born on May 6, 1912 in Lowell, the daughter of the late Otto and Helene (Schindler) Schliebus.

Peg was raised in Lowell and graduated from Lowell High with the Class of 1929. She and her husband, Maurice resided in West Tewksbury, MA for over 40 years. She was an avid golfer, playing well into her 90’s, and was a 50 year member at Vesper Country Club of Tyngsboro, MA. Peg was lucky enough to be honored on her 100th birthday by the Red Sox at Fenway Park last year during Fenway’s 100th birthday and was even featured on Fenway’s large screen television.

Family members include her two daughters, Brenda M. McDermott and her husband Frank V. of Rye Beach, and Shelagh Loughlin and her husband Richard of Concord, MA and her stepdaughter Joanne McGann of Lee. She is also survived by her grandchildren, Dr. Francis V. McDermott, III, Susan Condrey Reade, Christopher A. McDermott, Caroline Loughlin and Elizabeth Loughlin, her 7 great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her husbands, Maurice D. Condrey who died in 1972 and Joseph L. McElholm who died in 1993 and her brothers Hans and Herbert Schliebus.

There will be no calling hours. A mass of Christian burial was celebrated April 23, 2013 at St. Theresa Parish, 815 Central Rd., Rye Beach.
