Her garden bloomed every spring, cared for with hard working hands. Everyone was welcome in her home, her castle. Everyone who ever knew her loved her. Her great-grandchildren and grandchildren admired her throughout their lives. She was nothing but kind and dedicated and loved.

Marguerite is survived by her daughter, Bernice, and her husband, Buster, along with her grandchildren, Kim, Dustin, and Wade, and her five great-grandchildren, Chloe, Cole, Macy, Tess, and Zane, and dozens of cousins near and far. She will forever be remembered and celebrated as a woman who persevered and left a long-lasting and memorable legacy.
