North Hampton - Marianne Tarr Armacost, 86, of North Hampton, passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by her loving family, on Sunday, February 4, 2024. 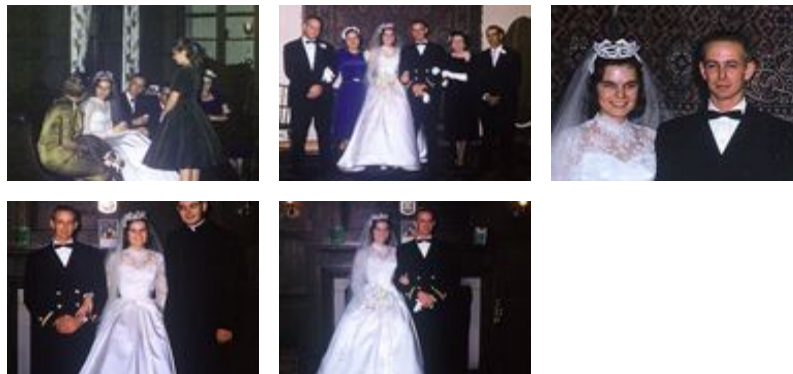
