



## Marie O. Carpenter

April 17, 1926 - October 5, 2013

Hampton – Marie O. Carpenter, 87, of Hampton, formerly of Somersworth, died Saturday, October 5, 2013, at home surrounded by her loving family.

She was born at home in Somersworth, April 17, 1926, a daughter of the late Joseph and Delvina (Beaupre) Ouellette.
