Hampton – Marilyn J. White, 87, of Hampton died peacefully, Monday, March 7, 2016 at her home.

She was born October 28, 1928 in Beverly, Mass., the daughter of the late Edward G. and Jessie (Young) Ferry.

Mrs. White graduated from Malden, Mass., High School with the Class of 1946 and Academy Modern in Boston.
