North Hampton – Marjorie C. Zona, 84, of North Hampton, died January 16, 2015 at Webster at Rye. Marge, as she liked to be called, was the much beloved wife of Salvatore Zona.

She was born in Franklin, Mass., on September 18, 1930. She grew up in Franklin, vacationed with family and friends on Cape Cod, and graduated from Franklin High School in 1948. She earned a Merchandising Associates degree at Dean Junior College, also in Franklin, in 1950.

In 1952, Marge moved to Portland, Maine and worked for an insurance company. Marge learned to play violin as a child, and continued to play in her new home as a member of the Portland Symphony Orchestra. In 1963, Marge moved to Rye, and worked as a bank teller at the First National Bank of Portsmouth's branch in Rye, now TD Bank, which is where she and Sal met.

Marge loved to play golf and was very good at it, hitting them 'long and straight'. She really enjoyed playing golf on the NH Seacoast, and was a former member of the Wentworth by the Sea Country Club and the Breakfast Hill Golf Club. When she was not golfing, she enjoyed reading, crafting and travel. She and Sal travelled to Spain, Italy, Morocco and France, but Montreal was her favorite city and the two of them went there many times. She spent her later winters on Hutchinson Island in Florida with family and friends and

enjoyed the beach and naturally, golf.

Survivors include her husband, Salvatore Zona, of North Hampton, her sister, Pauline Geishecker of Duxbury, Mass. and several nephews and nieces.

She was predeceased by her brother, Claude Samuel Chittick and sister, Esther Scanlon.

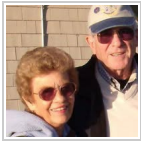
