Hampton – Mark “Junie” Der, 76, of Hampton, formerly of Arlington, MA, Tewksbury, MA and Exeter, died at Massachusetts General Hospital on Sunday, January 4, 2015 surrounded by his loving family.

He was born January 15, 1938 in Boston, MA, a son of the late Mark and Antoinette (Farino) Der.

Mark was raised in Arlington and was a graduate of Arlington High. He enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served his country as a Radioman Third Class onboard a naval ship during the Bay of Pigs Invasion. Mark was a simple, hard-working man who loved his family. He was a single parent who raised his three children by himself. Mark was a collector for the MBTA and retired after 27 years of service. He was an incredible human being, a charismatic, generous, giving individual and a real stand-up guy who would do anything to help a family member or friend in their time of need. Mark loved sports and was a devoted Red Sox fan. He moved from Tewksbury to Exeter in 1971 and to Hampton in 2006.

Mark is survived by his daughters, Karin A. Der of Hampton and Wendy S. Dries and her husband, Richard of Middleboro, MA; his son, Marc W. Der of King’s Mountain, NC; his sister, Mary Lyman and her husband Edward of Westford, MA and his longtime companion, Anne Backes of Hampton. He also

leaves 7 grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren, 3 nephews and his extended family, the Allen's of Arlington, who raised Mark and helped to make him the man he became.
