Hampton – Mark A. Loopley, 61, of Hampton, died Monday, September 29, 2014 at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston.

He was born in Springfield, Mass., October 3, 1952 a son of Frank W. Loopley of Hampton and the late Jennie A. (Amelisko) Loopley.

Mark graduated from High School in western, Massachusetts and attended Husson College in Bangor, ME. He was employed as an maintenance engineer for NextEra Energy Resources at Seabrook Station with 28 years of service retiring last June.

He served on the Hampton planning board and conservation commission and made his home here since 1978. His hobbies included playing golf and fishing.

In addition to his father, he leaves his wife Donna R.
