Raymond – Mark A. “Sparky” Perkins, 55, of Raymond, died on Tuesday, March 29, 2016 at his home, surrounded by loving family, after a courageous struggle with cancer.

Mark was born on March 14, 1961 in Exeter, a son of Wilbur D. Perkins of Merrimack and the late Mary E. (White) Perkins

Mark was raised in North Hampton and was a 1979 graduate of Winnacunnet High School in Hampton. Upon graduation, he went to work for McDevitt Trucks of Manchester. Mark was a hard worker and was the transmission and driveline specialist at McDevitt for over 37 years before he became ill. He was also employed at Abeniqui Carriers of North Hampton for the last 10 years.

Above all else, Mark was a family man. His wife and children were his world and he cherished them with all his heart. He was a fantastic provider and his family was never in want. Mark had a gift for socializing; he was always smiling and made others around him feel good. 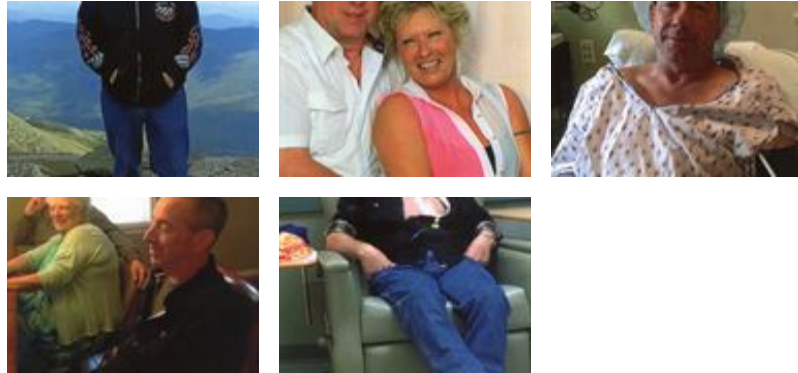
