Hampton – Marland Jewell Moore, 96, of Hampton, died peacefully on Monday, February 6, 2017 at Rochester Manor.

He was born in Hampton on November 30, 1920 a son of the late Christopher D. and Grace (Jewell) Moore.

Raised in Hampton he went to school at Hampton Academy. Following graduation he went on to work at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard Yard for a couple of years before enlisting in the United States Navy, where he served on board the USS Cascade during WW II and Korea.

After his time in the Navy he returned home and went back to work at the PNSY retiring after 35 years of Government service. He later worked many years as a grounds keeper for Sagamore Hampton Golf Club in Hampton.

Marland was a member of St. James Lodge #102 F&AM of Hampton, Hampton's American Legion Post #35 and a former member of the Hampton River Boat Club. He loved his cars, boats and RVing with his late wife Phyllis (Plaisted) Moore who predeceased him in 2014.

Elwood Robbins of Florida plus several nieces and nephews all over the country.
