



## Martha L. Littlefield Settles

October 3, 1950 - May 12, 2015

Seabrook – Martha L. Littlefield Settles, 64, of Seabrook, died peacefully on Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at the Exeter Hospital after a brief battle with Mesothelioma. She was surrounded by her devoted and loving family.

She was born October 3, 1950 in Amesbury, MA, a daughter of the late Clyde and Flossie (Stanley) Littlefield.

Martha was raised in Seabrook and had lived there most of her life. She was a graduate of Winnacunnet High School with the Class of 1968 and went on to earn her Associates Degree in Business Administration from Great Bay Community College. Martha was perhaps best known for her commitment to the Town of Seabrook and her many volunteer efforts. She worked with the Seabrook Historical Society and especially enjoyed researching family genealogy for many Seabrook families. Martha spent countless hours in fund raising for the American Cancer Society including organizing the Seabrook ON-T.R.A.A.C. Relay for Life team that raised money through yard sales, dances, races and fund raising meals at many local restaurants. She was a member of the Hampton Falls Grange, the Seabrook Lions and the Raymond E. Walton American Legion Post 70 of Seabrook. She was also a strong supporter of Seabrook's L&W Racing Team. Above all else, Martha loved her family and spending time with her grandchildren gave her a special joy. She will be sadly missed by her family and her many dear friends.

She is survived by her daughters, Kelly-Ann Glover Birbeck of Seabrook and Karen Davis and her husband Richard of Rochester; her sister, Annie Haughton of Seabrook, as well as her 7 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews. Martha also leaves her best friend of 20 plus years, Emmogene Maguire of Hampton and her little dog, Chewy, that she treated as one of her kids.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her brothers, Alfred and Herbert Kelly, her twin, John A. Littlefield, Sr. and her longtime companion, Charles Chase, Sr.

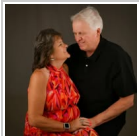
