Newmarket- Martin Jude O'Keefe, (Marty) age 62, of Newmarket, peacefully passed away from Frontotemporal Degeneration on November, 17, 2023.

Martin was born on August 17, 1961, in Methuen MA. He lived in Lawrence, MA before moving to Seabrook Beach. He attended Seabrook Elementary School, Winnacunnet High School, and Clark University.

In 1985, Marty opened the much-loved Round Rock Restaurant on Seabrook Beach. Marty made many friends and countless memories over the 17 years he owned and operated the neighborhood bar and grill. After selling the restaurant in 2002, Marty moved on to a career in sales and enjoyed 11 years living in Florida, before returning to New Hampshire with his family in 2015.

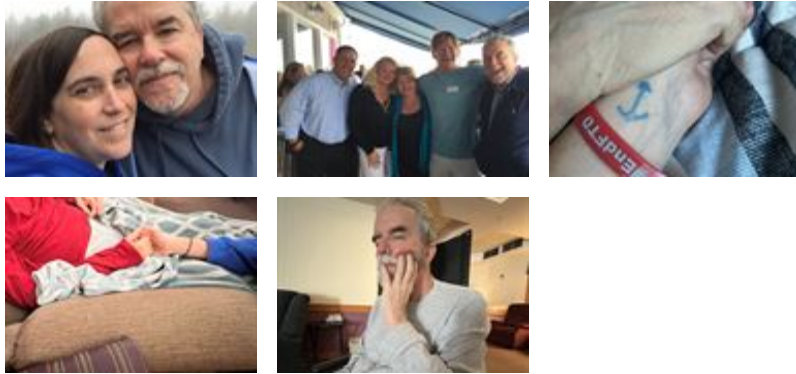
