Hampton – Mary C. Gregg, 81, of Hampton, died Sunday, June 29, 2014 at the Colonial Poplin Nursing Home in Fremont, with loving family by her bedside.

Mary was born in Barre, VT, January 13, 1933, a daughter of the late Matthew and Gertrude (Coughlin) O'Hagan. She earned her Bachelor's Degree from Mt.
