



## Mary Louise Pace

June 4, 1936 - August 16, 2019

Seabrook – Mary Louise Pace, 83, of Seabrook, died peacefully surrounded by her loving family on Friday, August 16, 2019 at Watson Fields in Dover.

She was born in Lawrence, MA June 4, 1936, the daughter of the late Harry F. and Gabrielle (Claus) Leslie.
