Rye - Mary E. (Corliss) Woods, 86, died Monday, August 19, 2013 at Webster of Rye.

She was born in Newburyport, MA on June 7, 1927, a daughter of the late James J. and Grace (Meehan) Corliss.

Mary was a graduate of Amesbury High School with the Class of 1945. After graduation, she entered the Sisters of Saint Joseph of Boston and taught foreign languages in various schools of the Archdiocese of Boston under the name of Sister Thomas Aquinas. Mary received her bachelor's degree from Regis College, her masters from Providence College and many more credits from Trinity College in Hartford, Ct. and the New England Classical Institute at Tufts University.

Mary was an active member of the Saint Theresa Parish of Rye and contributed her talents and her great love of the Lord as a Eucharistic Minister. She served in this ministry for thirteen years and considered the distribution of the Holy Eucharist to the sick and disabled a very special privilege. She could always be counted upon to actively contribute her assistance in the preparation of bereavement luncheons.

She was a life-long and highly knowledgeable Red Sox fan whose successes

and failures she could recall and comment upon years after they occurred.

She is survived by her sisters, Jane Hovey of Boston, MA and Kathryn Roth and her husband Dr. Irwin Roth of Chatham, MA and by several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Gerald T. Woods.
