



## Michael Glenn Hancock

June 11, 1950 - October 11, 2024

Nottingham - Michael Glenn Hancock, 74, of Nottingham, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, October 11, 2024, surrounded by his family. He was the loving husband of Kathy (Newcomb) Hancock.

Born in Covington, VA on June 11, 1950, Mike was the son of the late George and Dorothy (Via) Hancock. Raised and educated in Covington, Mike attended Covington High School and graduated in 1968. Mike was drafted in 1970 and served in the United States Army in Vietnam.
