



## Michael T. Madden

June 20, 1954 - April 1, 2022

Rye, NH - Michael Thomas Madden, 67, of Rye, formerly of Sudbury, MA, passed away at home surrounded by his family on April 1, 2022.

He was born to parents Michael and Theresa Madden on June 20, 1954, in Flushing, NY. He graduated from Brooklyn Technical High School, The City College of New York with a Bachelor of Chemical Engineering, and Manhattan College with a Master of Science in Chemical Engineering. He earned his Professional Engineers License.

Michael was the dear and devoted husband of Mellissa Madden, the loving father of Michael Madden and his wife Katharine Kelley of Melrose, MA and Katherine Haug and her husband David Haug of New York, NY. He was the cherished grandfather of Nova Madden, the dear brother of Marian, Paul, John, and Catherine Madden, and uncle to several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Michael started his career in 1977 with C-E Lummus in Bloomfield, NJ. In 1980 he accepted a position with Raytheon Engineers & Constructors – Badger Engineers in Cambridge, MA. In 2002 he joined ExxonMobil in Spring, TX where he remained until his retirement in June 2019. During his working career Mike traveled extensively. He and his family had the opportunity to live in Holland, England, and Spain. In addition, he made several solo trips to

Russia, Japan, India, France, China, Korea, and Sweden.

Michael had several interests – fishing, running, sailing, traveling, historical fiction, and spending time with family. He shared many of these interests with his children, teaching them how to fish at a young age, inspiring them to take up running, and regaling them with history lessons about places they traveled to. In Rye, he found a town that embodied all these interests. You could find him running along Ocean Boulevard, checking out the boats at Rye Harbor, and visiting local landmarks with his family.
