



## Miriam E. Trisdale

June 22, 1952 - September 22, 2025

Miriam E. Trisdale, 73, of Seabrook, passed away on Monday, September 22, 2025.

Born in Boston, MA, on June 22, 1952, she was the daughter of the late Hans and Beverly (Dushane) Edel. She shared 44 years of marriage with her husband, Steve Trisdale.

Miriam was raised in Boston and graduated from Brighton High School, Class of 1970. She went on to earn her undergraduate degree from Suffolk University in 1974 and later earned a Master's degree in Speech Pathology from Northeastern University. She was extremely passionate about her career, working as a speech pathologist at Timberlane High School, Sanborn Regional High School, and Oyster River, where she made a lasting impact on countless students and colleagues.

Beyond her career, Miriam lived a life filled with service, creativity, and connection. She enjoyed crafting and traveling, was a proud member of the Seabrook Lions Club, and frequently volunteered at the Seabrook Community Table. Most recently, she became a member of Congregation Ahavas Achim in Newburyport, MA. Her favorite place to go was the zoo—wherever her travels took her, she sought out any zoo she could visit. She also loved playing mini golf with her grandson.

Miriam will be remembered as outgoing, social, genuine, honest, and selfless. She always put her family first, had a deep love for her cats, Snowball and Wiley, and cherished her time with loved ones.

In addition to her husband Steve, she leaves her son Wally and her daughter-in-law Sarah of Worcester, MA, and her beloved grandson, Lucas. She is also survived by her sisters Linda Bunson and husband Stanley of VA, and Diane Cohen and husband Howard of Franklin, MA. Her niece Julie Goldberg and her husband Brandon, and their children Evie and Ethan Goldberg; her nephew Geoffrey Bunson and his daughter Lucy Bunson. She also leaves her brother-in-law Phillip Trisdale and sister-in-law Debbie Trisdale.

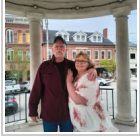
