North Hampton – Nancy C. Buzzell, 66, of North Hampton and Walterboro, SC, died Friday, July 19, 2013 at her North Hampton home after a recent diagnosis of large cell lymphoma with her family at her side.

She was born in Boston, Mass., November 25, 1946 the daughter of Robert E. and Gladys C. (Foster) Stokinger of Portland, Me.

She graduated from Algonquin Regional High School in Northborough, Mass. and attended Dean Junior College in Franklin, Mass. In her earlier years she worked for Continental Cablevision and throughout the 1980's as a beloved bus driver in the Portsmouth school district for Timberlane Transportation.

Nancy's greatest joy, were her grandchildren. She was a member of the United Church of Christ, the Ladies Union, and the North Hampton Woman's Club. She enjoyed sewing, crocheting, ceramics, swimming and was a longtime volunteer for the Multiple Sclerosis Society and one of those years was named volunteer of the year.

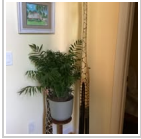

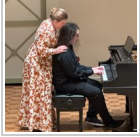

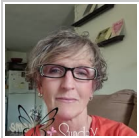
