Hampton – Nancy M. Lundin, 79, of Hampton, formerly of Amherst, died Tuesday, June 9, 2021, at her home with family by her side. She was born in Holyoke, MA February 10, 1942, a daughter of the late Robert N. and Ethel (Gray) Morrison.
