My Uncle Neil will be keeping his eye on me.

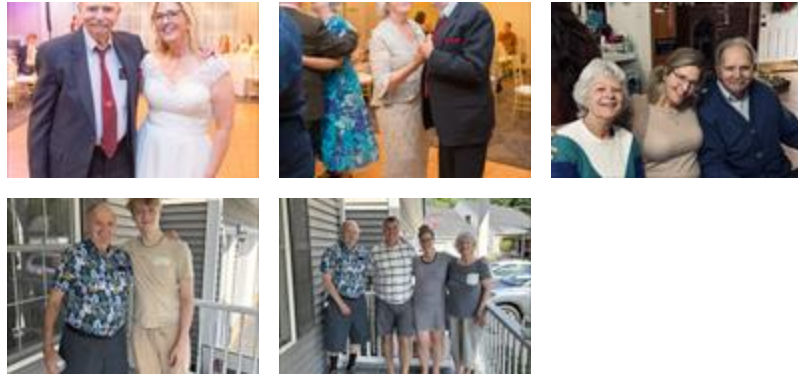

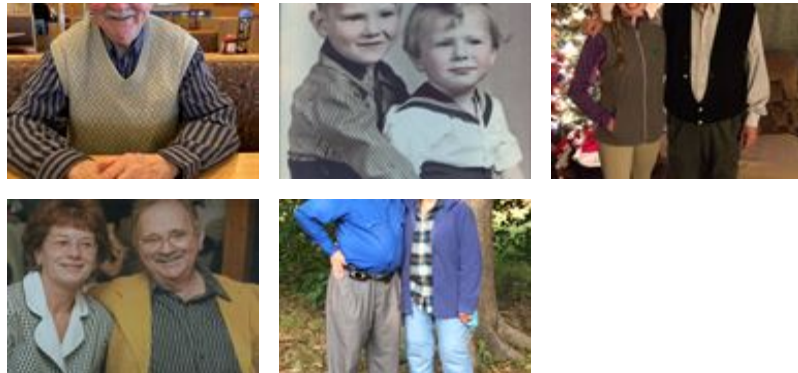
