North Hampton- Norma L. Brindamour, 100, of North Hampton, died Thursday, March 6, 2025. Mrs. Brindamour was born in Medford, MA, on September 25, 1924, a daughter of the late William and Mabel (Leahy) Sullivan.

She was raised in Medford and graduated from Girls Catholic High School of Malden, MA with the Class of 1942. Norma then earned her nursing degree from Saint Elizabeth's Hospital School of Nursing in Brighton, MA. She was very proud of the fact that while at nursing school she volunteered as a Cadet Nurse during the war.

After graduation, she worked at a number of hospitals in MA before getting married in 1947 and moving to NH to raise her family. She worked at Anna Jaques Hospital in Newburyport, MA, and eventually went to work at Exeter Family Health. She became an Advance Registered Nurse Practitioner for over 20 years before retiring in 1996.

Norma was a communicant of St. Theresa Church in Rye Beach and a member of their women's club. She was also a member of the Hampton Lions Club and enjoyed playing bridge. Norma's extraordinary sense of humor, kind smile and willingness to help others will be sadly missed by all who knew and loved her.

Family members include her daughter-in-law Sue Brindamour of Kingston, her grandchildren Jason, Joshua, Ashley, Brett and Robert Brindamour, 5 great grandchildren, her beloved niece, Maureen Jensen, with whom she shared an especially close relationship; and many other nieces and nephews.
