Rye – Norma L. Skinner, 94, of Rye, died Friday, August 22, 2014 at Webster at Rye.

She was born in Lynn, Mass., April 20, 1920 the daughter of the late Sven and Hanna (Lundstead) Olson.

Mrs. Skinner was raised in Lynn and graduated from Lynn Classical High School with the Class of 1937 and Katharine Gibbs Secretarial School, Boston, Mass., in 1939. She was employed as a secretary by A.C. Lawrence Company in Peabody, Mass. and also the Lynn Item before she began raising her family.

While raising her boys she was Cub Scout den mother and later volunteered her time at the Lynn Union Hospital as well as the Morristown Hospital in Morristown, NJ while living in New Jersey.

She made her home in Rye since 1983 coming from New Jersey where she was active in civic groups on the seacoast. She enjoyed working with the Rye Garden Club with plantings at the intersection of Cable and Central Roads and was an active member of the Friends of the Rye Public Library and held an integral role in fundraising for a 1988 building campaign among other important initiatives.

She shared over 65 years of marriage with her late husband, Irving S. Skinner who predeceased her in 2012.

Family members include three sons, Paul R. Skinner of Boston, Mass., Robert S. Skinner and wife Nancy of San Mateo, CA, David J. Skinner and wife Paula of Charleston, SC, her two grandchildren, Brett and Brady Skinner, two nieces and one nephew.

She was also predeceased by her two brothers, John and Stanley Olson.
