



## Norman H. Yeaton

February 4, 1948 - November 8, 2025

East Wakefield – Norman H. Yeaton, 77, of East Wakefield and former longtime resident of Rye, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, November 8, 2025, in Sebastian, Florida.

Born February 4, 1948, in Portsmouth, NH, Norman was the son of the late Herbert and Arlene (Tucker) Yeaton. Raised in Rye, he graduated from Portsmouth High School and later Southern Maine Vocational Technical College in South Portland, ME.

A proud U.S. Navy veteran, Norman served honorably for several years before returning home to begin his career as a carpenter.
