Rye – Olga M. Mitchell, 94 of Rye formerly of Boston, MA, died Friday, April 25, 2014 at Webster at Rye.

She was born in South Boston, MA August 5, 1919, the daughter of the late Simon and Alexandra (Patapova) Udaly. At age 15, she graduated from Girls High School in Boston. She resided in Boston until moving to Rye in 1975.

Olga was the wife of Philip Mitchell and together they operated Mitchell Service, an appliance repair company where she was bookkeeper and general office administrator. After he died in 1965, she carried on running the business until all her children had left college. She then joined Portsmouth Naval Shipyard where she had ten enjoyable years of work.

She was an enthusiastic volunteer. She was a member and driver for the Rye Volunteer Ambulance Corps and volunteered for many years at Webster at Rye, where she was Volunteer of the Year in 2002.

Family members include two daughters, Laura Mazur and her husband, Boleslaw of London, England and Susan Wall and her husband, Thomas of Hull, MA and , two sons, Kenneth Mitchell and his wife, Janet of Exeter and

Philip Mitchell and his wife, Deborah of Santa Rosa, CA; three grandchildren, Deborah, Jennifer, and Kenneth; a great granddaughter, Avery; a brother, John Udaloy of New Castle; a sister, Evelyn Obbard of South Yarmouth, MA; and several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her sister-in-law, Judith G. Udaloy, who died in March.

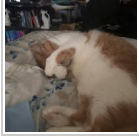
“ *Nana,
