



Orawan "Bonnie" Brosnahan

March 17, 1918 - November 9, 2014

Orawan "Bonnie" Bunnag Brosnahan, 95 years old, peacefully passed away on Sunday, November 9th, 2014, at Oceanside Skilled Nursing Facility, Hampton, New Hampshire. She was well loved and cared for from both all Oceanside Skilled Nursing Facility staff and the SolAmor Hospice of New Hampshire team.

"Bonnie" was born in Chiang Mai, the northern part of Thailand, and lived in Bangkok, Thailand. She was widowed when her first husband, Lieutenant-General Suraphan Bunnag, who passed away in 1946. In 1975, she travelled to the USA to live with her daughter, Veodao Nu Bunnag. In 2001, "Bonnie" married to her recently deceased husband, Walter R. Brosnahan, and they both resided in Raymond, New Hampshire, until the end of October, 2013.

While "Bonnie" lived in Bangkok, she was a nurse and volunteered for both The Thai Red Cross and Girl Scouts of Thailand. Because of her determinations and devotions to civic duties, she received many honorable medals for her efforts.

"Bonnie's" accomplishments were commendable and endless. She was a proud US citizen.

She volunteered at Rockingham County Nursing Home, Brentwood, New Hampshire, for many years and received recognitions as one of the

volunteers. At The Rockingham Craftsmen Spring Fair in Plaistow, New Hampshire, “Bonnie” was among forty exhibitors who was honored by the Standards Committee for her unique paper flower. She loved to photograph, sew all her garments, knit and crochet many scarves and hats for the family, and cook her special Thai fried rice. She was the world traveler.

Her survivors to “Bonnie” are her daughter, Veodao Nu Bunnag of Portsmouth, New Hampshire, her two beloved grandchildren, Jennifer Goodrich of Brookline, Massachusetts; Joshua Goodrich of Brooklyn, New York; and her great-grandson, Eric Heilhecker, son of Jennifer Goodrich and Tyson Heilhecker.

“Bonnie’s” private cremation service was held at Remick and Gendron Funeral Home-Crematory, Hampton, on Wednesday, November 12th 2014 at 9:00 a.m.
