Seabrook - P. Richard Bilodeau, 81, of Seabrook and formerly of South Lawrence, MA died on Sunday, Christmas Day, December 25, 2016. His devoted wife Joyce and his children were by his bedside.

He was born March 25, 1935 in Lawrence, the son of the late Armand W. and Annette M. (Hamel) Bilodeau.

Raised in Lawrence, he graduated from Central Catholic High School with the Class of 1953 and attended Lowell Tech and Wentworth Institute in Boston. Mr. Bilodeau was a veteran serving with the US Coast Guard.

Richard was employed in the engineering division of Raytheon Corporation in Andover, MA, working in quality assurance for over 25 years. After his retirement, he was employed part time with the Remick & Gendron Funeral Home-Crematory in Hampton.

Richard had fond memories of his time as a leader with Boy Scout Troop 13 in Lawrence, MA. He was an active member and head usher of the First Baptist Church in Hampton Falls and had made his home on the seacoast since 1991 coming from South Lawrence, MA.
