



## Patricia H. Davis

March 15, 1942 - June 13, 2017

The Villages, FL - Patricia H. Davis, 75, died peacefully surrounded by family on Tuesday June 13, 2017 at Cornerstone Hospice & Palliative Care after a long battle with cancer.

Pat was born on March 15, 1942 in Boston, Mass., the daughter of the late Joseph and Evelyn Dostie. She attended and graduated Roxbury Memorial High School, with the Class of 1959.

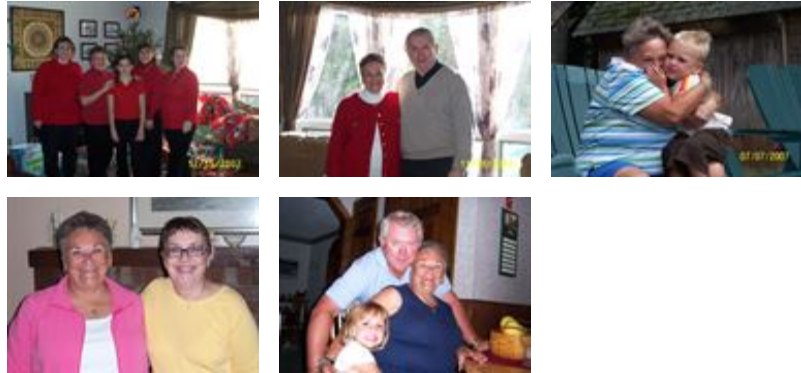
