Hampton, NH – Former Seabrook Police Chief Patrick Manthorn, 62, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 3, 2014 surrounded by his family and wife Carol holding his hand.

Born March 17, 1951 in Ipswich, MA on St Patrick's Day and named appropriately, to the late Edward and Regina (Farrell) Manthorn.
