Greenland - Paul L. Henderson, 77, passed away peacefully on January 19th at home in Greenland, NH with his family.

Paul was raised in Cranford, NJ and attended Rutgers University in New Brunswick and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. He served in the United States Air Force and was stationed at Nellis Air Force Base in Las Vegas, NV. He began his career in the Hotel Casino business after he was discharged in the spring of 1970. When casino gaming opened in Atlantic City, NJ in 1979, Paul transferred to New Jersey with Caesars.

Paul was president of international marketing for all three Caesars resorts in Las Vegas, Atlantic City and Tahoe. Paul was president of the Atlantic City Hilton, Trump Castle, as well as Caesars. Paul was a “people person”. He created an atmosphere of fun. He was instrumental in bringing the beach bar concept to Atlantic City with the creation of the “Dizzy Dolphin” beach bar. He said of his employees “The best way in the world to work with people is to be involved with them; to get down there and walk amongst them and talk about philosophy, attitude and courtesy. There has never been a program installed in a casino property that has been better than that.”

Paul was an avid golfer, he enjoyed woodworking and after retirement in 2005, he built a wonderful woodworking shop and created some amazing

furniture.

Paul was a loving husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. Paul was predeceased by his loving daughter, Virginia Lynn Wallace (Gina). He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Joyce, his son-in-law Michael Wallace of Northfield, NJ, Jon & Amanda Henderson of Orono, ME, Peter Henderson of Northfield, NJ, James and Elizabeth Henderson of Greenland, NH, grandchildren, Anthony LaMaina, Jonathan Wallace, Isabel, Samuel, Adam, Lola, Scarlett, Carter, and Gwen Henderson, a great grandson, Grayson Jayce and his sister Lynn Cardinale and nieces Margot and Gillian Cardinale.
