Hampton – Paul A. “Chickie” Lefebvre, Sr., 86, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 30, 2017 at the Oceanside Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Hampton.

Paul was born in Manchester on April 24, 1931, a son of the late Napoleon and Germaine (Couture) Lefebvre.

He graduated from Manchester West High School with the Class of 1949 and enlisted in the New Hampshire Air National Guard soon after. In 1952 he met his wife Doris (Lisai) Lefebvre; they were married for 61 years, and have lived in Hampton since 1964. Paul retired from the New Hampshire Air National Guard in 1983, and in their retirement years Paul and Doris loved traveling around the country in their RV. Key West was a favorite destination, where Paul loved to fish.

Paul is survived by his wife Doris; his sons, Paul A. Lefebvre Jr. of Falmouth, MA , Timothy A. Lefebvre and his wife Andrea of Portsmouth, and Jeffrey M. Lefebvre and his wife Michele of Evergreen, CO; his grandchildren Tyler and Rachael Lefebvre and Justine McPherson; his sister-in-law Kay Caron and her husband Richard; as well as his many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brother Wilfred and his

sisters, Marguerite Comeau and Rachel Thompson.
