



## Pauline A. Dupuis

April 14, 1932 - September 26, 2023

Seabrook – Pauline A. Dupuis, 91, of Seabrook, has gone home to God and passed away peacefully on Tuesday, September 26, 2023. She was born on April 14, 1932, in Haverhill, MA, a daughter of the late Ralph L. and Lenora O. (Bouvier) Moll.

Pauline was a graduate of St. Joseph High School in Haverhill with the Class of 1950 and from Tewksbury State Hospital School of Nursing in 1960. She was employed as a nurse at the former Hale Hospital in Haverhill for 35 years, retiring in 1987.

In 1965, Pauline moved from Haverhill to Seabrook, NH. She was a faithful communicant of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Parish from 1994 to 2022 and served her church with great love and care as sacristan till 2016.

She was predeceased by her siblings, Wallace J. Moll, Richard V. Moll, Clement C. Moll, Paul R. Moll and Jeannette Kapela and is survived by their children and grandchildren.
