



## Peter J. Casella Jr.

January 30, 1946 - February 20, 2018

Hampton – Peter J. Casella, Jr., 72, of Hampton, passed away suddenly at his home on Tuesday, February 20, 2018.

Peter was born in Hartford, CT on January 30, 1946 a son to the late Peter J. and Alice (Baker) Casella, Sr. He was raised in Manchester, CT and entered the United States Navy after graduation from high school. In 1967, after honorably serving his country, Pete married the love of his life, Linda (Anderson) Casella. Pete learned his trade in the Navy and worked as a machinist before purchasing Columbia Screw/Pete's Pegs of Derry, NH in 1984.

Pete moved the business to Hampton in 1991. He adored his family, liked to play golf and enjoyed showing his 1938 Ford Street Rod.

He was a devout man, loved his church and loved Jesus Christ. He was a member of the Bethany Church in Greenland and an active participant with the First Monday for Men Group and as The Dessert Man at Midweek programs.

Pete lived his life as taught through Thessalonians 4:11-12 "Do all you can to live a peaceful life. Take care of your own business, and do your own work as we have already told you. If you do, then people who are not believers will

respect you, and you will not have to depend on others for what you need.”

Windsor, CT.

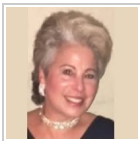

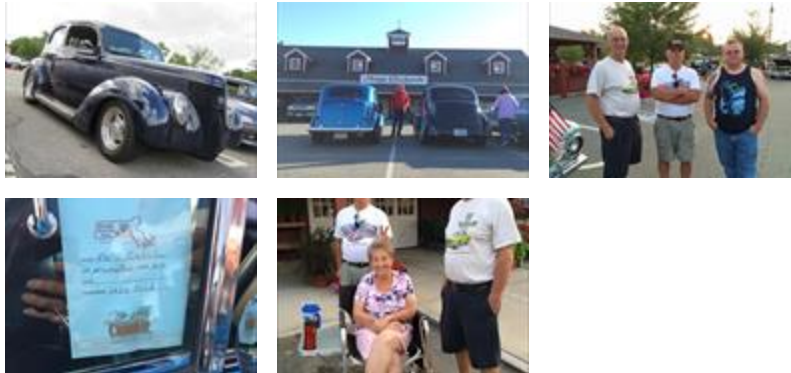
