Seabrook – Peter W. Chatman, 78, of Seabrook, died Friday, August 6, 2021. He was born in Gloucester, MA February 11, 1943, the son of the late Alice Frances (Chatman) Pelletier and Louis Pelletier.

Peter spent his youth in Beverly, MA and moved to Newburyport, MA in the 1970's. He then moved to Seabrook in 2011 which he loved and found everyone he met to be warm and friendly.

Peter graduated from Beverly High School with the Class of 1961. He attended Bentley College of Accounting and Finance and Northern Essex Community College. During his youth he was active in the First Baptist Church of Beverly.

He was employed as accounting clerk for John J. Brady & Sons, Inc., in Massachusetts and Florida for many years and then with the John F. MacDonald Companies for 15 years before retiring from Mobile Storage Group in 2004.
