



Peter C. McCue

January 31, 1952 - February 1, 2022

Rye - Peter C. McCue of Rye NH passed away peacefully at Portsmouth Regional Hospital on Tuesday, February 1st. Peter was predeceased by wife Annie Casey, parents Charles J. McCue, Sr. & Elizabeth (Quigley) McCue, and sister Betsy McCue.

He is survived by his daughter Melissa Monahan, her husband Colby Monahan of North Hampton, NH, and their children, his beloved granddaughters, Charlie and Willow and his former wife Amy Golov of Wayland, MA.

Additionally, he is survived by his stepmother Margaret McCue of Rye, NH, his siblings Mark and Mary McCue of Boston, MA. Katie and Ralph Kenawell of Melrose, MA, Chuck and Kim McCue of Portsmouth, NH and Maureen and Louis Falcone of Mashpee, MA.

Peter was a constant presence in the lives of his family and especially his nieces and nephews, Cara and Tanner, Andrew and Caroline, Morgan, Nolan, Hannah, Meg, Anna, Aidan, Spencer, and Luke.

Peter was born on January 31st, 1952 and grew up in Arlington, MA and Rye Beach, NH. He graduated from St. Sebastian's School in Needham, MA in 1970 and from Boston College in 1975. Peter had a distinguished professional

career with the Xerox Corporation and rose through the ranks of Xerox into senior management specializing in global accounts.

Peter suffered from liver disease from the time he was very young and had a successful liver transplant in 1992. He went on to cofound the New England Chapter of the American Liver Foundation in 1997 that today continues to educate and impact those with liver disease. Peter also had a successful kidney transplant in 2011 with his brother in law Ralph Kenawell as the donor.

It was with great sadness that Peter lost his wife and friend Annie Casey in 2011. However, Peter's perseverance through his life was remarkable and as was his style he found a way to turn every obstacle into a positive. He never complained, he simply fought each fight and moved on to the next. He lived life to the fullest.

Peter was a lifelong member of Abeniqui Country Club in Rye, NH where he was an avid golfer and a fierce competitor on the tennis courts as a multiple time club champion.

His favorite things were time with his friends and family, long walks on Jenness Beach, a cup of coffee from Summer Sessions, attending his garden, projects around his home, family cookouts and time on his screened porch.

He was always focused on what was next, what was possible and how to get there.

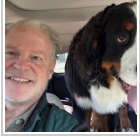
