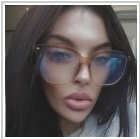

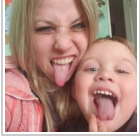

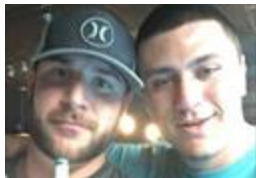


“ I went to high school with phil ,saw him all the time at dunks,he always had a smile on his face,was in the best mood. He was doing so well. This is such a shock
