



## Philip M. Jarosz

December 30, 1945 - October 11, 2022

Hampton - Philip Michael Jarosz, 76, of Hampton, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, October 11, 2022.

Philip was born to the late Mildred and Andrew Jarosz on December 30, 1945 in Harvey, Illinois. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Bradley University in Peoria, Illinois.

Philip entered the Army and was stationed in Korea, assigned to the Seventh Infantry Division Honor Guard. Philip and Margaret "Peggy" were married in 1969. He began working for the Internal Revenue Service as a Revenue Officer and eventually for Whiting Corporation in Harvey. Philip and Peggy were members of St Victor Parish in Calumet City, Illinois where he served on its outreach team offering counseling and facilitating interventions for alcoholics. Philip transferred to division headquarters at Liberty Lane in Hampton, to work eventually for Fisher Scientific. His last seventeen years until retirement were spent as Controller for Secondwind Water Systems in Manchester.

Philip and Peggy have lived in Hampton and have been parishioners of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal for thirty-seven years. Philip served ten years on the board of New Generation in Greenland as its Treasurer.

Philip is survived by his wife, Peggy, son, Michael and sister, Sharon Medley and her husband David and their daughter Mindy Kedvesh and family.
