Hampton – Randall Paul Noyes, 66, of Hampton, and a former resident of Pittsburg, NH, passed away suddenly on Saturday, September 9, 2017 at Exeter Hospital with devoted and loving family at his side.

Randy was born on July 20, 1951 in West Stewartstown, a son of the late George A. and Alice G. (Pariseau) Noyes, II. He was raised in Pittsburg and graduated from Pittsburg High in 1969. Randy later enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps and after honorably serving his country, he returned home and relocated to Colorado. He moved to Hampton and was introduced to the love of his life, Lori (Bishop) Noyes, through his sister, Pam Bishop. They married a year later in 1988. Randy worked for the Town of Hampton, and then Hewlett Packard and then hired as a Senior Help Desk Technician at the Mentor Network.

A generous, loving, kind man with a huge heart, Randy would help anyone in their time of need. He was dedicated to his family and his work and was a great provider who sincerely cared about everyone he met. He helped form Cub Scout Pack 176 of Hampton by becoming Scoutmaster. He ensured no boy would get turned away from becoming a cub scout. He was a loving father and a good mentor to other kids. He loved to cook and eat, enjoyed watching movies with his family and was a huge Pats fan. Randy was very active in the Hampton First Baptist Church, serving on various committees and as church

Deacon.

In addition to Lori, his loving wife of 29 years, Randy is survived by his children, Joseph (Mika), Matthew (Chelsea), Joshua and Makayla Noyes. He also leaves his brothers, George (Carole), Daniel and Michael, his sisters Cheryl Cote (Paul), Julie Rathier (Russell) and Pamela Bishop (Kenny), as well as numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.
