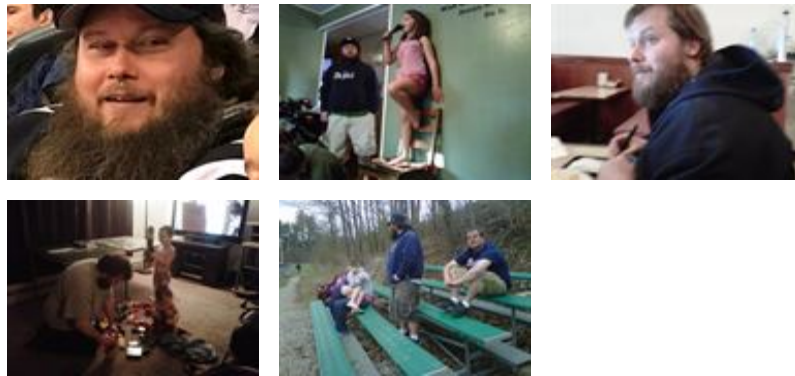

Now some know you as fugal coupon shopping and sales. But they don't know you never spent money on you. The clothes you wore to work at times were duck taped together. Your shoes were old. But if a family member wanted to borrow money you did it and didn't complain when you didn't get paid back. I would get upset not you. That's the past and you always did it for the little ones.

The Games you and Raymond took kids to will forever be in there hearts. At the hospital Brayden said, Auntie can I please just see Randy to tell him I love him. I said not now honey we are praying he gets better so you can tease him. He started to laugh & cry at the same time. From a nine year old. Last night Mason, said Auntie Nay are you sad? I looked at him and said, Do I look sad? He said, yes

My heart hurts. You were in such pain the last few weeks, and still did your walks with family. I'm angry with myself .Why didn't I know what was happening ? How does a son have a stroke ,when the Dr, 2 weeks before said , your on the right track losing weight and taking care of yourself ? I keep asking myself What could I have done. to keep you here.
