November 2, 1939 - January 21, 2016

Plant City, FL – Raymond C. Sturgis, 76, of Plant City, formerly of Seabrook, died January 21, 2016 at South Florida Baptist Hospital.

He was born in Portsmouth, NH, November 2, 1939 and was the son of the late Raymond and Eleanor (Felch) Sturgis.

Ray attended Hampton, NH schools, graduated from New Hampton Preparatory School in New Hampton, NH and later attended the University of Miami in Florida.

He was employed for many years at the Baily Corporation in Seabrook and for Foss Manufacturing in Hampton. He also served as Bail Commissioner for over 30 years. In his younger years he helped his father at the former Sturgis Funeral Home in Hampton.

A longtime resident of Seabrook, Ray enjoyed his vegetable garden, making his special relish, cooking, clam digging, feeding the birds in his backyard and was a chaperone for several class trips overseas for Winnacunnet High School. He resided in Florida the past 3 years.

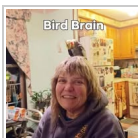
