Hampton Beach, NH – Regina Lattime, 48, of Hampton Beach, died Thursday, January 22, 2015 at her home after losing her long-standing battle with the ravages of chronic illness.

She was in Harriman, TN March 28, 1966 a daughter of Brenda (Eaton) Cromwell and the Late Carl W. Lattime.

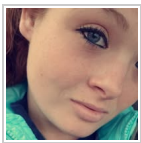
