He was a proud man and enjoyed caring for the house he and Eli shared. He was always meticulous and quite creative with his landscaping and home improvements, including the handmade fire pit in the backyard and the custom tilework in his garage.

Above all else, Reinaldo was a great man, a wonderful son, the best husband, a most devoted father who loved to talk to his children and a great provider for his family. He was a sweet and humble man with never a harsh word for anyone. He will be sadly missed by those he loved and those who knew and loved him.

In addition to Eli, the love of his life, Reinaldo is survived by his mother Miriam of San Juan, his father Isidro of Luquillo, his son Reinaldo Andres Orozco of Orlando, FL and his daughter, Andrea Paola Orozco of CO. 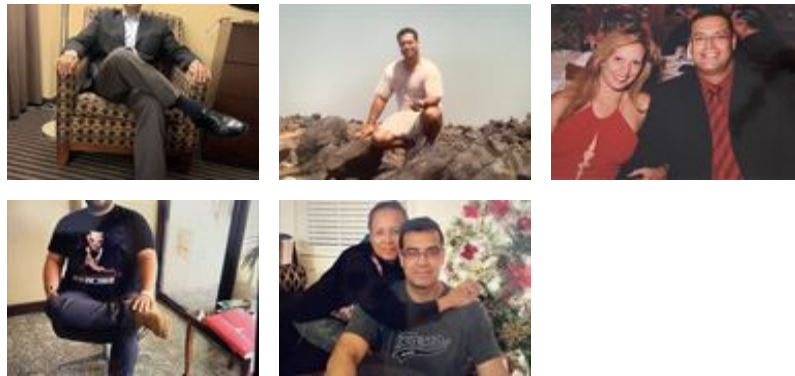


“ I worked with ray the last few years and was a wonderful person and co worker just wanted to send the family my prayers and to say a saying that we would say to each other each day during shift change
