Hampton - Rene J. Bonnin, 68, of Hampton died peacefully on Saturday, February 18, 2017 at Exeter, Hospital.

He was born in Danielson, CT on November 6, 1948 a son of the late Joseph and Marguerite (Mazarella) Bonnin.

Raised in Lawrence, Mass., he graduated from Lawrence High School. He went on to enlist in the United States Army, serving 3 years with 1 tour in Vietnam. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with two Bronze Stars, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Good Conduct Medal, two Overseas Bars, and Sharpshooter. After his time in the service, Rene, known as Angel, started his career at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, as a Tool Room Mechanics Supervisor, retiring in 2008.

Rene enjoyed spending time with his dog Rocco, (his wife would say too much time), was an avid Patriots fan and active in supporting the Republican Party. He wrote many letters to the editor throughout seacoast newspapers supporting the Republican Party.
