



Richard "Dick" Bradley

June 15, 1939 - October 15, 2014

HAMPTON - Richard A. "Dick" Bradley, 75, died Wednesday, Oct. 15, 2014, at Rockingham County Nursing Home, Brentwood, after a lengthy battle with Alzheimer's disease.

He was born June 15, 1939, in Nashua, the son of the late Maurice A. and Dora (McLellan) Bradley, and had resided in Hampton since 1976. He was a 1959 graduate of Nashua High School.

Mr. Bradley retired as a sales and service representative with Alltex Uniform of Manchester after 25 years of service and had previously worked for Interstate Uniform Co., of Nashua and Colonial Services of Portsmouth and Rochester in the same capacity. He served as a police officer with the Nashua Police Department for several years.

He was a former communicant of St. Louis de Gonzague Church in Nashua and in his earlier years he coached the church's youth group basketball team for many years.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Claudette (Landry) Bradley of Hampton; two sons, Jeffrey Bradley of Hampton and Richard Bradley and his wife Kathleen of Derry; four granddaughters, Allison, Kellie and Emily Bradley of Epping, and Katrina Bradley of Derry; one great-grandson of Epping; one

brother, Paul Bradley of Meredith; two sisters, Cora Phillips of California and Mary Jane McLellan of Litchfield; his former daughter-in-law, Teresa Walker of Epping; and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by two brothers, William Bradley and Thomas Bradley; and one sister, Gladys St.Jacques.

There are no calling hours. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated Saturday, Oct. 25, 2014, at 10 a.m. in St. Louis de Gonzague Church, 48 West Hollis St., Nashua. Interment will follow in St. Louis Cemetery, Nashua. A celebration of life reception will be held following the burial.
