Seabrook - Richard Leslie Fowler, of Seabrook, passed away at home on Thursday, July 4, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. He was 78 years old.

Born in Newburyport on August 18, 1945, Richard was the son of the late Robert W. Fowler and Phila (Knowles) Sturgis. Richard grew up in Seabrook and then went on to enlist in the United States Army. Upon returning from the Army, Richard spent over 20 years as a Sergeant with the Seabrook Police Department. He loved to watch Sports especially the red sox, Patriots, the Bruins and golf. He loved to play Words with Friends with people and play Bingo on his computer. He loved to spend time with his daughter Myra & Friend Rita & Loan taking rides in the Car singing Gospel music and old Country songs he loved to dance and sing his favorite was Hank Williams. He loved spending time with his "Baby" April as he would always introduce her to people as MY BABY. And his most favorite was spending time with his Pride and Joy his Grandson Dylan Janvrin he loved him so very much. Family meant everything to him.

Richard is survived by his daughters, April Fowler, of Seabrook, and Myra Fowler of Seabrook. He is also survived by his brothers Milan "Butch" Knowles of Seabrook, and Gary Fowler and his wife June, of Seabrook. 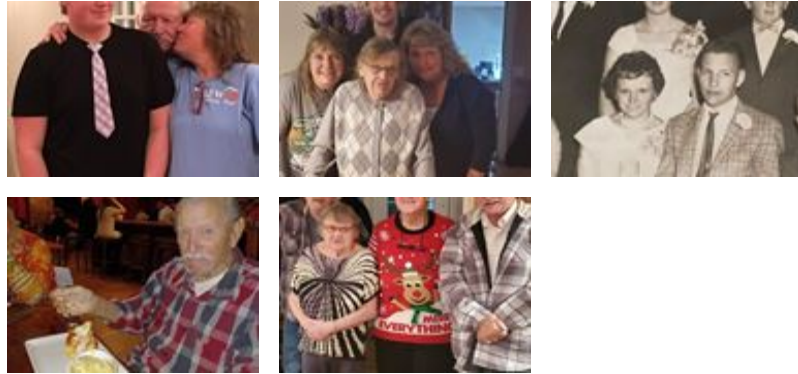
