Hampton - Rico Crovetti, 94, formerly of Hampton, died Monday, November 24, 2014 at Holy Family Hospital at Merrimack Valley in Haverhill, Mass.

He was born March 14, 1920 in Carney, IA, March 14, 1920 the son of the late Girolamo and Pia (Guigla) Crovetti.

He graduated from Amesbury High School, Amesbury, Mass. and was a veteran of WW II serving with the US Army.

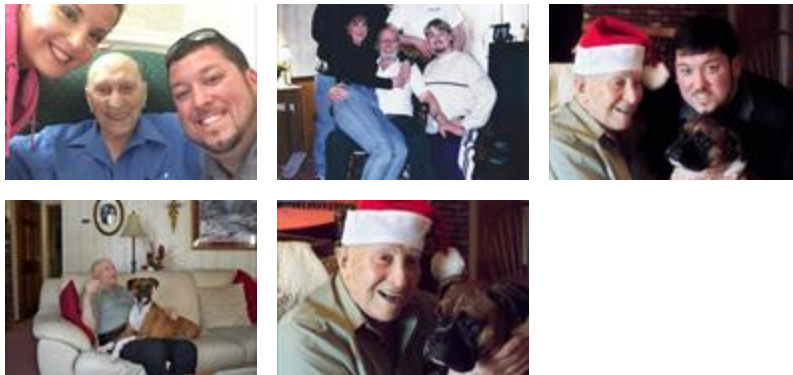
