Greenland – Ritchie Buchanan, 92, of Greenland, died Thursday, December 1, 2016 at the Veterans Affairs Boston Healthcare System, West Roxbury, Mass. Campus surrounded by loving family.

He was born August 4, 1924 in Lynn, MA the son of the late Richie and Anna (Cummings) Buchanan. He was a veteran of WW II serving with the US Navy.

Richie was raised in Boston and graduated from Boston Latin High School and later Lowell Technical Institute. He worked as a sales representative in the industrial supply cleaning field for many years. He was also employed as a union carpenter at the Seabrook Power plant for the 10 year period it was being built. For the past 17 years and up to the time of his death he worked for BMW of Stratham.

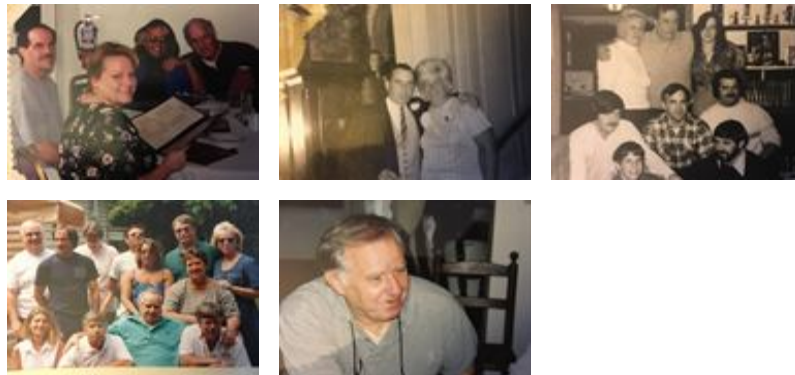
