Seabrook - Robert "Duck" L. Ducker, 86, of Seabrook, passed away on Monday, December 15, 2025, at Exeter Hospital. He was the loving husband of Doreen Ducker.

Born in Stoneham, MA, on October 17, 1939, Robert was the son of the late George A. and Alice (Currie) Ducker. Raised in Reading and a proud graduate of the Reading High School Class of 1957. He was a veteran who served his country in the United States Army. He achieved the impressive status of professional golfer and was a successful entrepreneur who owned his own business. Showing that it's never too late to learn a new skill, he earned his pilot's license in his 40s and frequently flew his Cherokee 6. He shared his life with his wife, Doreen, whom he married on April 18, 2006.

Between professional sports and piloting his own plane, he clearly embraced challenges.
